Psalm 34:1 I will bless the Lord at all times; his praise shall continually be in my mouth. **2** My soul makes its boast in the Lord; let the humble hear and be glad. **3** O magnify the Lord with me, and let us exalt his name together. **4** I sought the Lord, and he answered me, and delivered me from all my fears. **5** Look to him, and be radiant; so your faces shall never be ashamed. **6** This poor soul cried, and was heard by the Lord, and was saved from every trouble. **7** The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear him, and delivers them. **8 O taste and see that the Lord is good; happy are those who take refuge in him.** **9** O fear the Lord, you his holy ones, for those who fear him have no want. **10** The young lions suffer want and hunger, but those who seek the Lord lack no good thing.

11 Come, O children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the Lord. **12** Which of you desires life, and covets many days to enjoy good? **13** Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking deceit. **14** Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it. **15** The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, and his ears are open to their cry. **16** The face of the Lord is against evildoers, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth. **17** When the righteous cry for help, the Lord hears, and rescues them from all their troubles. **18** The Lord is near to the brokenhearted, and saves the crushed in spirit. **19** Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the Lord rescues them from them all. **20** He keeps all their bones; not one of them will be broken. **21** Evil brings death to the wicked, and those who hate the righteous will be condemned. **22** The Lord redeems the life of his servants; none of those who take refuge in him will be condemned.
